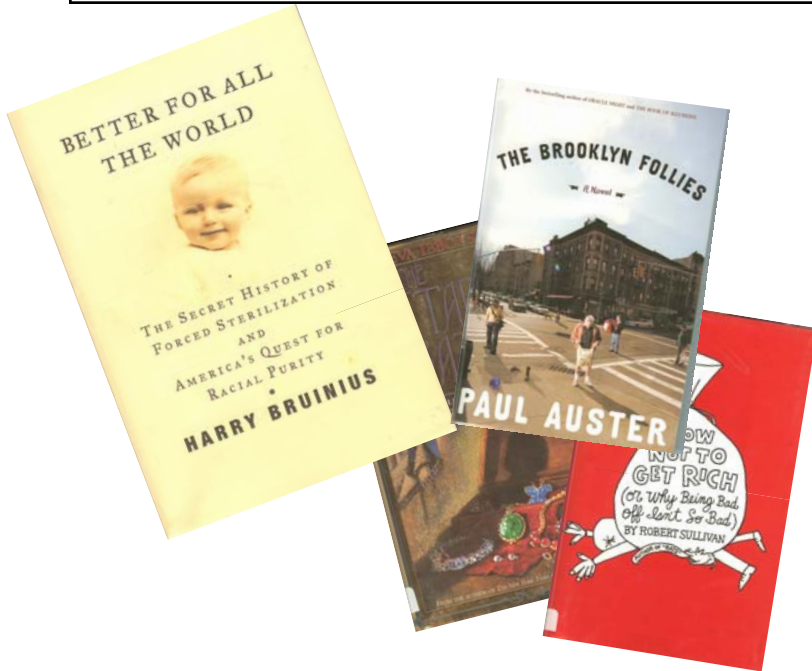


Library Bulletin

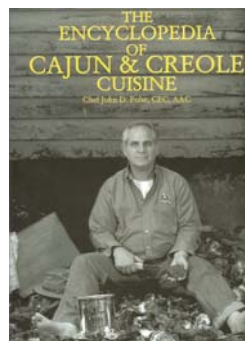

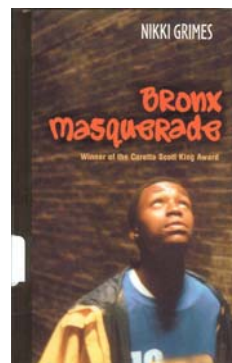

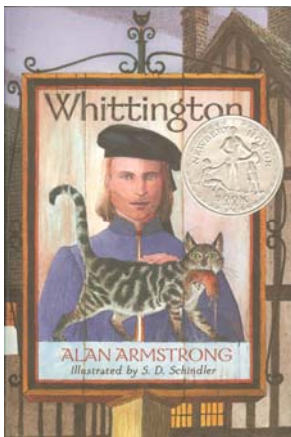
